Adult State Fees: \$20.00

National registration checks payable to NAA
State tournament registration checks payable to the WFAA
If shooting both, checks payable to the WFAA

Round information:

Two ends of practice begin at 9:30 a.m. Scoring begins at 10 a.m. - one line only

All scoring is the same as NAA scoring.

FITA equipment rules enforced.

Most notably, arrows must be 2315 (9mm) or smaller in diameter and must have shooter's initials on each shaft. Compounds maximum draw weight is 60 pounds. No electronics allowed on the line.

Dress code enforced for all competitors
